# Overview

Before beginning to use the Pearson System of Courses, the app and content must be installed for the grade and subject. One way to do this is to download the app from the Chrome store and download the content. To do this you will need to be connected to the Internet and follow these three steps:

1. [Install](#) the app from the online store.
2. Change the [configuration code](#).
3. Log into the app with the Pearson System of Courses login credentials and [download](#) content for the subject and grade.

Deploying the Pearson System of Courses app and Pearson System of Courses content over the air (OTA) in a manual fashion allows for a deployment with little preparation. This process involves downloading the Pearson System of Courses app using the Chrome App Store (Google ID/email required), and then downloading the Pearson System of Courses content using the Pearson System of Courses app after login. Refer to Figure 1.

# Prerequisites and Assumptions

The following prerequisites must be met:

- Strong network connectivity recommended for completing over the air content deployment
- Google ID/email available for each device user
- Chromebook (touch or non-touch device)
- Latest Chrome operating system
- Internet access

## Restriction

Logging in on one platform (iOS/Windows/Chromebook) and then changing to another platform will cause the app to malfunction.

# Process

## Pearson System of Courses Deployment

The deployment consists of installing the Pearson System of Courses app and downloading Pearson System of Courses content onto the device.

### Step 1: Install Pearson System of Courses App

1. You must be signed in to the Chromebook device with the same Google ID/email account that will be associated with the device when using Pearson System of Courses.
2. Launch the Chrome Web Store into the Apps section:  
<https://chrome.google.com/webstore/category/apps?hl=en>.
3. In the search box, enter "Pearson System of Courses" and press **Enter**. Refer to Figure 2.
4. Click Add to Chrome and then click the **Add app** confirmation.

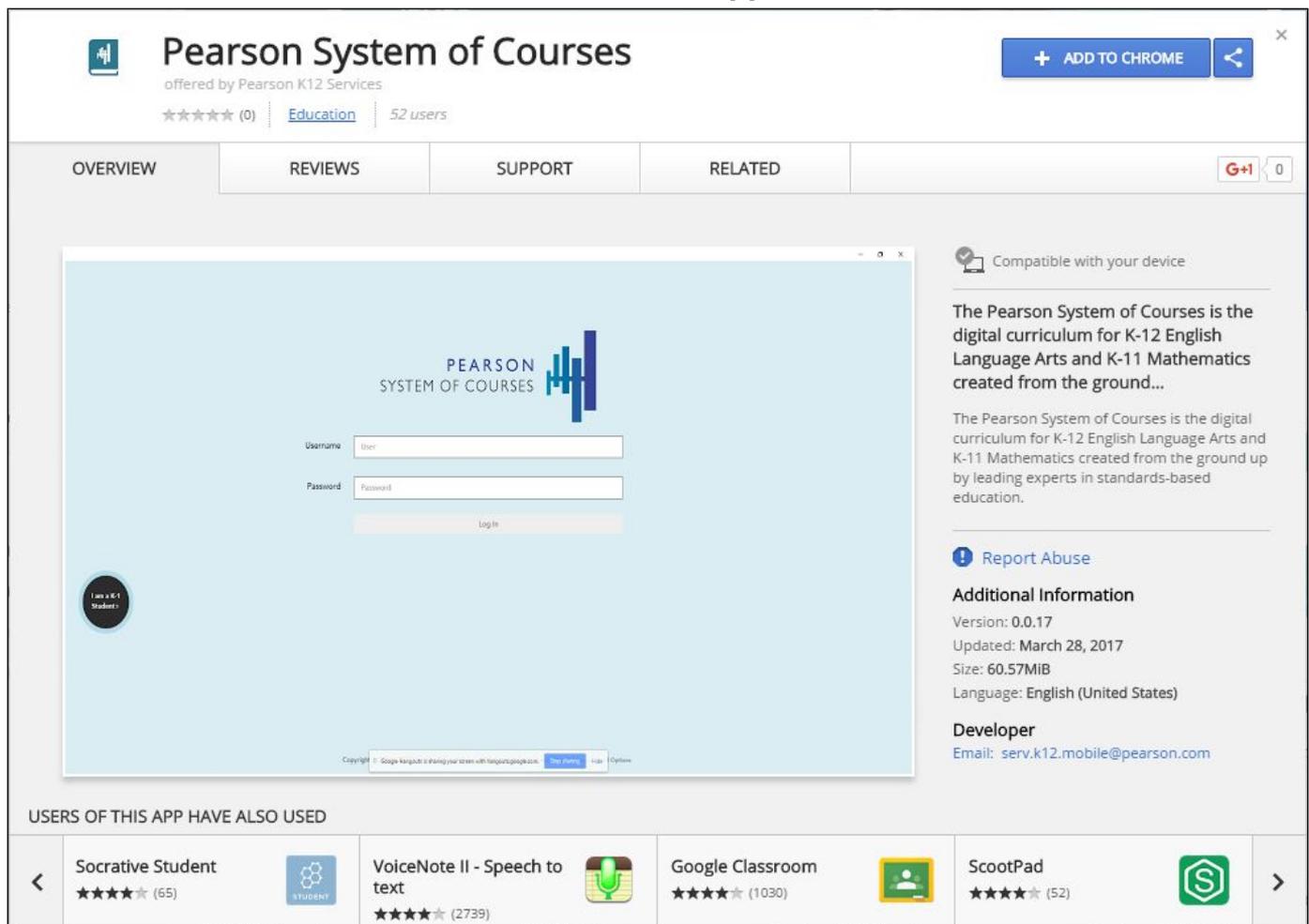
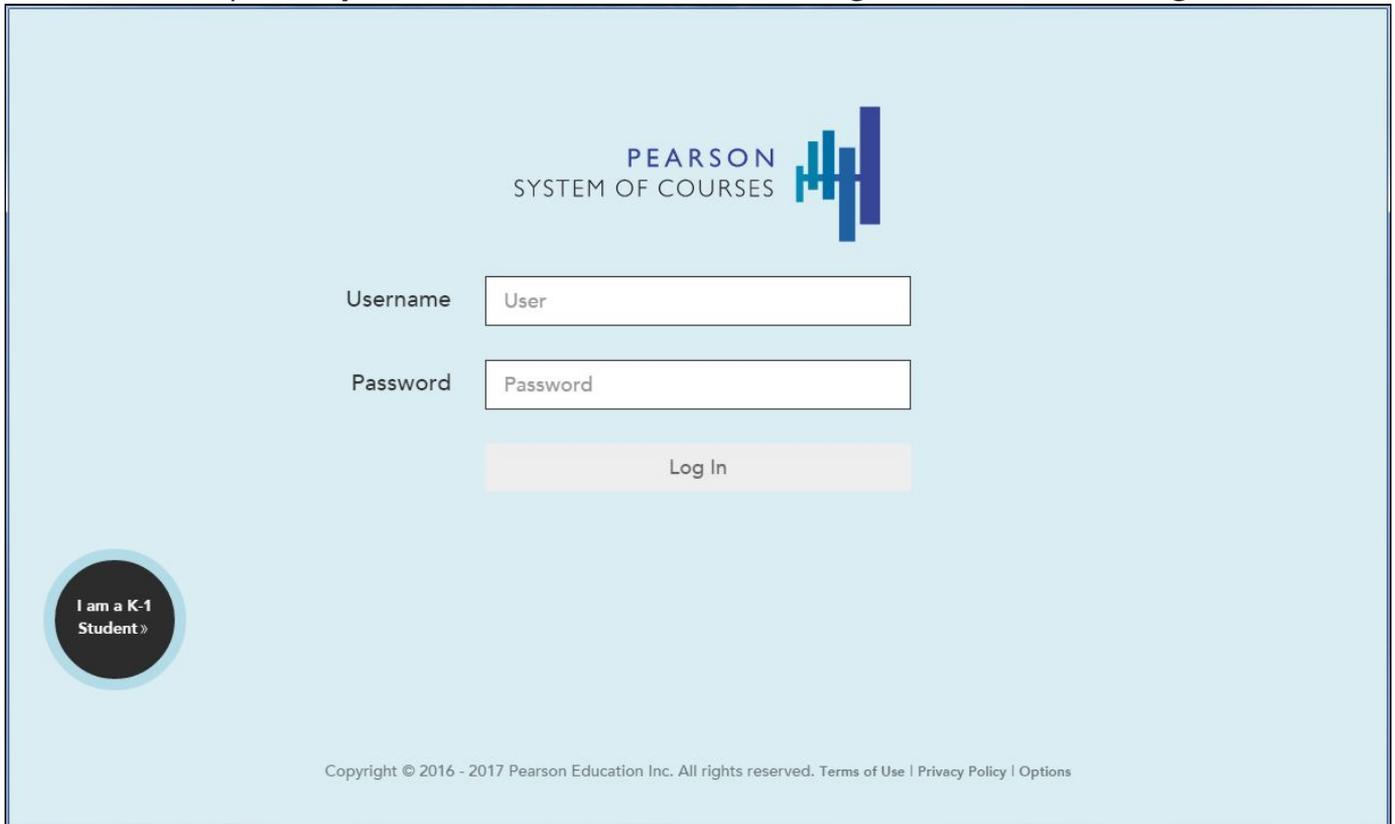

## Step 2: Change Pearson System of Courses Configuration Code

1. Launch the Pearson System of Courses app.
2. Tap the **Options** link at the bottom of the login screen. Refer to Figure 3.

3. Enter the appropriate configuration code (shown redacted here) for your district then tap **Save** button, then tap the **Back** button left arrow at the top of the screen. Refer to Figure 4.

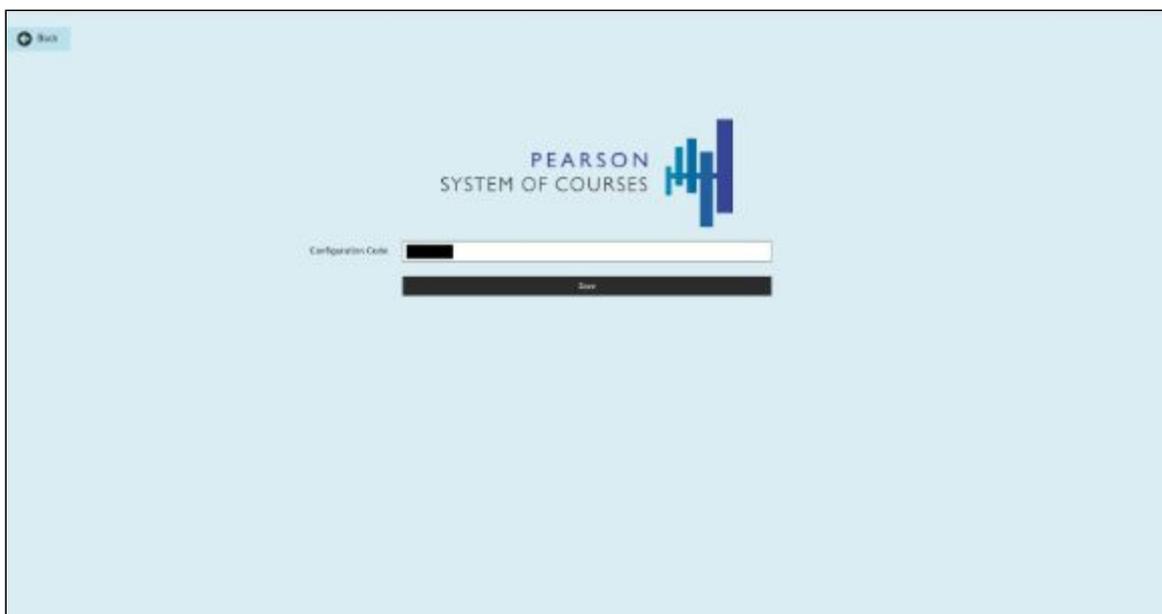

### Step 3: Login and Download Content (Over the Air for the Pearson System of Courses App)

1. Launch the Pearson System of Courses app.
2. Enter the name and password for the Pearson System of Courses user. Refer to Figure 5.

3. Pearson System of Courses content for the grade and subjects based on the user will download automatically upon the first login. **Note:** Only the base course information will be downloaded at this time. Full lesson content will be downloaded on-demand when the units are selected for downloaded. Refer to Figure 6.

- The Chromebook is now provisioned for the user's grade and subjects.
- When a user enters the Unit Manager for the first time, they will need to select one or more units to download. Once the unit download is complete they can start the unit and access all lessons in that unit even while other units may be downloading in the background. Refer to Figure 7.

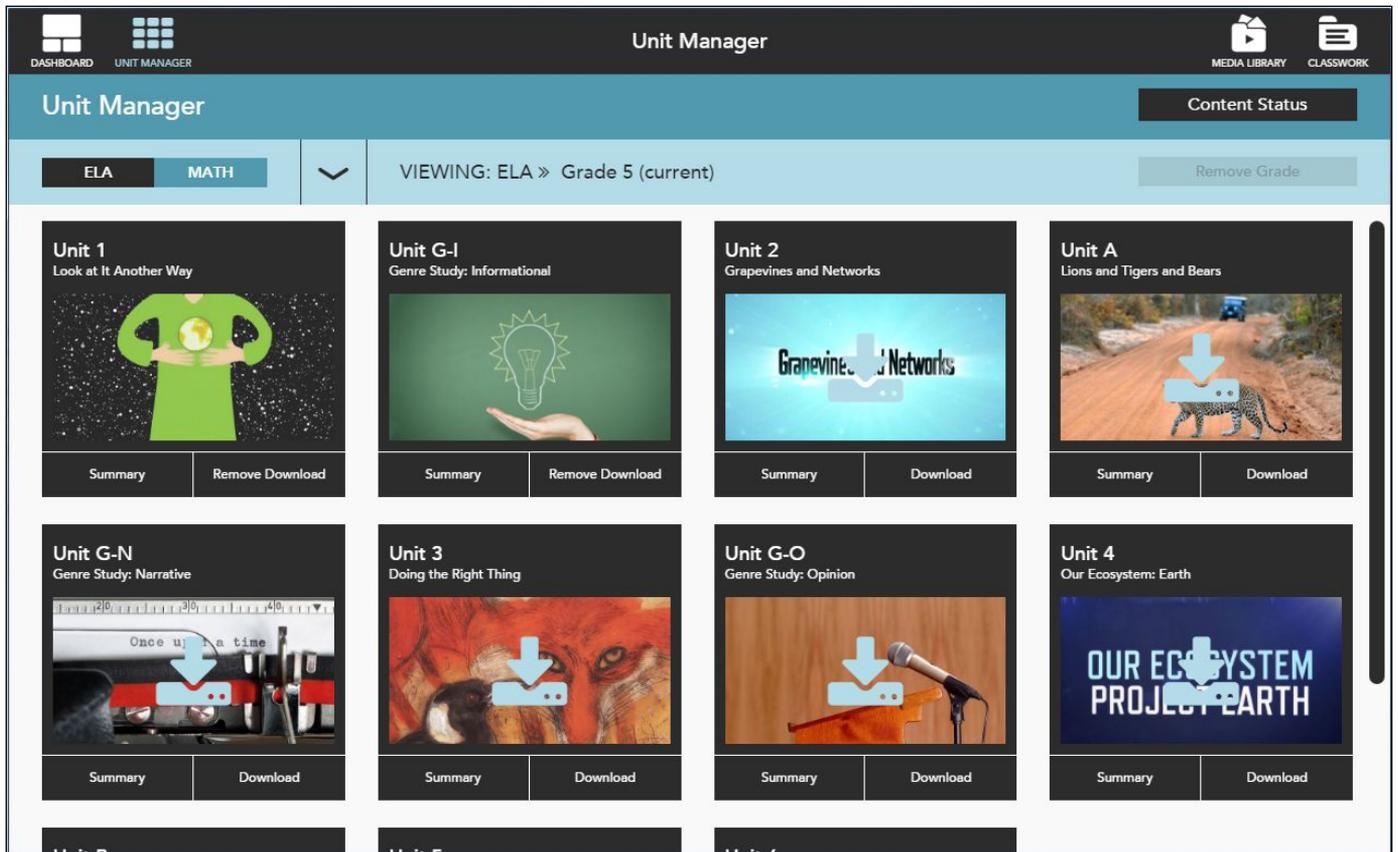

## Update the Pearson System of Courses App

The Pearson System of Courses app will automatically update to the new version when a new app update is released to the App Store.

Alternately, open `chrome://extensions/` on the device. See Figure 8. Ensure Pearson System of Courses is enabled and click **Update extensions now**.

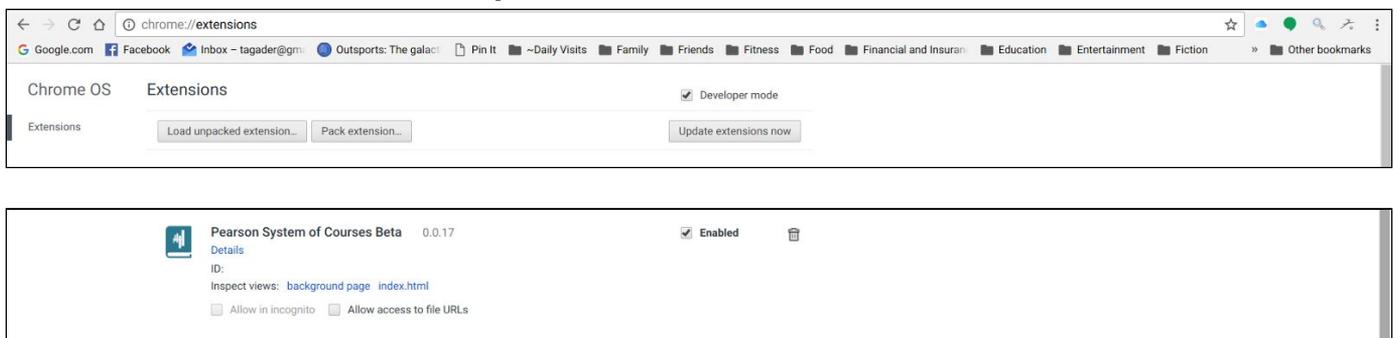

## Uninstall the Pearson System of Courses App

Open the Apps link and locate Pearson System of Courses. Right click on the icon and choose **Uninstall**. Refer to Figure 9.

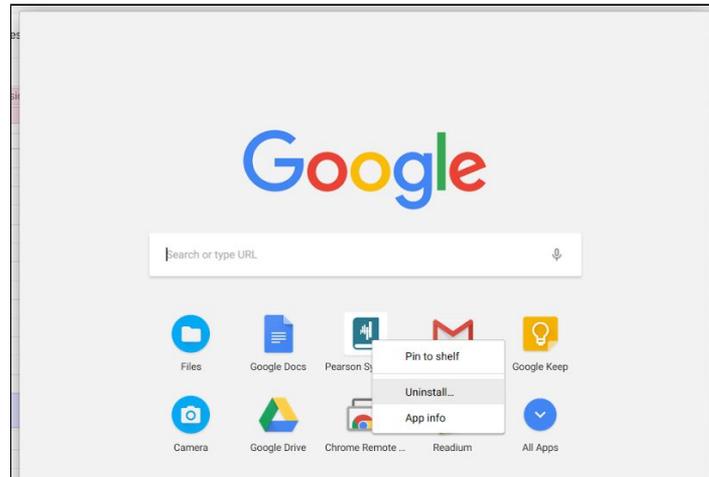

Alternately, open `chrome://extensions/` on the device. Find the app and click the **trash can** icon to remove the app. See Figure 10.
